ORDER


On December 6, 2011, the Plaintiff, Stephen P. Conklin ("Plaintiff"), filed a Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunctive Relief (Doc. 91) seeking to enjoin Defendants from "physically removing Plaintiff and his family from their home, as is currently set to occur on Thursday, December 8, 2011 at 2:00 p.m." Based on the facts alleged in Plaintiff's Complaint (Doc. 1), immediate and irreparable injury will result to Plaintiff before the Defendants can be heard in opposition if the ejectment scheduled for December 8, 2011 is permitted to take place.

This Temporary Restraining Order is issued to prevent the irreparable harm which will ensue if Plaintiff and Plaintiff's 83 year-old father are physically removed from the premises at 100 Spangler Road, Lewisberry, York County, Pennsylvania ("Premises"), since such removal presents a threat to the health and safety of Plaintiff and Plaintiff's father who resides with him.

This Order is issued without notice since the physical ejection scheduled for December 8, 2011, at 2:00 p.m., cannot be prevented before the Defendants are heard in opposition.

Given the foregoing, **NOW**, on this 7th day of **DECEMBER, 2011, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. Defendants are temporarily restrained from physically ejecting or removing Plaintiff and Plaintiff's family members from the Premises.
2. This Order shall expire in fourteen (14) days hence, to wit, on December 21, 2011.
3. Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunctive Relief (Doc. 91) is assigned to the Honorable Thomas M. Blewitt, U.S.M.J., for report and recommendation in accordance with FED. R. Civ. P. 65(b)(3).
